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

2. Infrastructure Feedback

The views of B.A. LLB & B.B.A. LLB (Integrated Five Years Course) students about infrastructural facilities during 2020-21. 41.9 per cent of the students viewed that there is an excellent facility of library. 44 per cent of the students considered that there is an excellent facilities of computer lab (Legal e-resources). 39.5 per cent of the students opined that there is good facility of classroom space and structure. 27.8 per cent of the students observed that there is an excellent facility of reading room. 32.6 per cent of the students considered the facility of girl's common room and boy's common room at the average level.

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
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documentaries, biopic and other resources etc. some even commented on the space constraints of the present library.


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
Graphical Analysis of Teachers Feedback Response (Academic Year 2021-2022)




Above graph specifies that 85.0 per cent of the teacher viewed that the syllabus provide a comprehensive design on teaching goals and learning outcomes is excellent.




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





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


Above graph describes that 96.0 per cent of the teacher opined that the sufficient reference materials and books are available for the topics mentioned in the syllabus.











Graphical Analysis of Employers Feedback Response (Academic Year 2020-2021)








Above graph illustrates that 98.0 per cent of the employers preferred to recruit more students from Anand Law College in the future.
