### **Course Explanation:**

The NGO Internship is a practical-oriented course designed to provide students with field exposure and an understanding of the functioning of Non-Governmental Organizations. During the one-month internship, students will work with an NGO engaged in areas such as legal aid, human rights protection, women and child welfare, education, environmental protection, rural development, health awareness, and community service.

Students will observe the organizational structure, participate in NGO activities, assist in awareness programmes, conduct field surveys, interact with beneficiaries, and understand the practical application of legal and social concepts.

The internship will bridge the gap between classroom learning and practical experiences by developing professional ethics, social responsibility, and legal service skills among students.

The same shall be evaluated by a board of examiners constituted by the Academic Program Committee of the College. In case of Affiliated Colleges, the board of examiners shall be constituted by a committee comprising of all faculty members of respective institutions involved in teaching in Law subject to the Students. The same board shall conduct the comprehensive viva of this semester.

### **Evaluation:**

The evaluation of the Fourth Semester Internship in NGO shall carry 50 marks (30+20). The performance of the students shall be assessed on the basis of their internship work, daily diary, activities undertaken during the internship, and the consolidated internship report.

After successful completion of the one-month internship, students shall submit a detailed internship report containing the objectives, activities performed, practical experiences, observations, and overall learning outcomes gained during the internship.



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The Internship Report and Performance Evaluation shall be conducted by a Board of Examiners consisting of the Dean, one External Examiner, one Faculty Member nominated by the Academic Planning Committee (APC), and the concerned Internship Supervisor.

**The evaluation shall include:**

**Assessment of internship activities and field performance – 30 Marks**

**Evaluation of internship report, presentation, and viva-voce – 20 Marks**

The Board of Examiners shall evaluate the student's practical understanding, participation, documentation skills, application of legal knowledge, and overall learning achieved through the internship experience.
