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To Pass	(1) A candidate must have at 70% of attendance in each semester of the LL.M. programme and shall have satisfactory performance in class participation, seminar, assignment of each paper and must have appeared in the internal written test, to be Eligible for grant of the respective semester except Semester-IV in which there will be no internal test. (2) A candidate for Semester-I if granted as prescribed in (1) above shall be allowed to proceed to Semester-II. (3) A candidate shall be allowed to proceed in Semester-III only after fully passing both Semester-I and Semester-II. (4) A candidate shall be allowed to proceed to the semester-IV only after fully passing both Semester-I and Semester-II and his/her Semester-III has been duly granted. (5) The candidate shall be eligible for the award of LL.M. Degree after successfully passing all papers/courses of Semesters I, II, III & IV. The candidate will be allowed to appear in the respective End-Semester Examination during validity of his LL.M. registration. (6) There shall be no ATKT or provision for exemption in the LL.M. Programme. (7) A candidate who fails in a paper/course due to failure in obtaining minimum marks in the internal head of the paper/course, the marks obtained in attendance, class participation seminar, Assignment, Internal test shall be carried forward till date validity of the registration and the terms granted continue. The Institution Rules about gracing of marks shall be followed.
