Course Objectives:	- To provide students with the expertise to draft various commercial and private instruments such as Sale Deeds, Mortgage Deeds, Lease Agreements, Gift Deeds, and Wills. 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Detailed Syllabus: Internship (Practical Two Week (BCI Norms))

Explanations	Students have to undergo a Compulsory Internship for Two Week and on that a report has to be submitted by each student separately. The same shall be evaluated by a board of examiners constituted by the Academic Program Committee of the College. In case of Affiliated Colleges, the board of examiners shall be constituted by a committee comprising of all faculty members of respective institutions involved in teaching in Law subject to the Students. The same board shall conduct the comprehensive viva of this Semester.
Internship Evaluation	50 marks (30 marks for External + 20 marks for Internal Viva / Internship Report) They shall be evaluated by the Board of Examiners consisting of Dean, an External Examiner and the supervisor concerned. After the completion of internship by the students, the work done by the candidate as recorded in his/her daily diary along with a consolidated internship report which include objective and overall learning from the internship. Internship Report would be evaluated by a Board of examiners consisting of Dean, an External Examiner and the Supervisor concerned.
One-Month Trial Court Internship	Every student must undergo a continuous one-month internship at a Trial Court (District or Taluka Court).
Certificate Course: Drafting, Pleading, and Conveyancing (DPC)	Simultaneously, it is compulsory for all students to complete the Certificate Course in Drafting, Pleading, and Conveyancing . This course bridges the gap between theoretical law and legal practice.
